

Graduate Credit FAQ for EduTech Training Workshops

Graduate Credit

Graduate credit from NDSU is available for most EduTech training workshops. EduTech tracks participant courses and hours. One graduate credit is available for 15-16 hours of instruction. ***NOTE: Workshop hours are available for two years from the date completed. If not used toward graduate credit within that time, they will expire. Duplicate workshops may not be used toward graduate credit.***

Tracking Hours

EduTech workshop hours are tracked and may be viewed in your training dashboard's "Personal Info" tab. On EduTech's home page at www.edutech.nodak.edu:

- Click on "Training" then "Dashboard"
- Log in with your EduTech (e-mail) username and password
- Select the "Personal Info" tab
- Click on the workshop bar for dates and other details

Classroom Applications of Technologies courses consist of 15-16 hours of accumulated, approved face-to-face hours offered and tracked by EduTech. *Workshop hours are available for two years from the date completed. If not used toward graduate credit within that time, they will expire. Duplicate workshops may not be used toward graduate credit.*

Requirements

Attend all class sessions and complete activities as assigned.

Registration/Costs

Each graduate credit requires 15-16 eligible EduTech training hours (PowerSchool, E-Rate, refresher and duplicate hours are not eligible). To register, go to www.edutech.nodak.edu, select "TRAINING" and then "Graduate Credit". A link to the registration form is also located in your training dashboard. EduTech will assign the appropriate course title to the credit. The current cost for each credit is \$75 (subject to change).

Grading

Letter grades or S/U grading is available. Grading is based on a rubric located at www.edutech.nodak.edu -> Training -> Graduate Credit.

Transcripts

Official NDSU transcripts are available for a \$5 fee from the NDSU Registration and Records Office. When the graduate credit processing is completed, an e-mail confirmation is sent to your EduTech account with instructions to order an official transcript.
